

How clean is your product?

It is the customer's responsibility to ensure that their products are clean when they are delivered to the port of export. The following is a quick but invaluable guide explaining what to look out for in order to ensure your product is clean enough.



Cargo within the vehicle

No cargo is to be carried within the vehicle



Food

There should be no evident traces of leftover or spilled food or drink. This includes food consumed by humans, or food carried as commercial produce.



Dirt

Road travel can throw up dirt. All traces of this, even from dirty water, must be washed and removed, paying special attention to the underside of the product.



Plant material

Plant material such as twigs, seeds, leaves, bark, roots, grass or straw must be removed from inside and outside of the product.



Animal material

Especially important is to ensure the removal of all animal and insect life, dead or alive, including traces of any insect contamination.



Oil and grease

All oil stains or leakage, grease, soot etc. must be removed from inside and outside the product.
